



### **Reginald Campbell Thompson Graduate Scholarship in Assyriology Degree**

**Type and subject:** Any candidate studying any course in Oriental Studies or Archaeology, who is specialising in Assyriology.

**Value of award:** Course fees and a grant for living costs for full-time students at the UK Research Council rate (currently £15,285 minimum) for the relevant period of fee liability; part time students will receive a proportional study support grant. Previous Oxford students are advised to check their fee liability on the [University's Fees and Funding pages](#) for any applicable adjustments to fee liability resulting from prior study.

**Residence criteria:** The Scholarship is open to all applicants.

**Partnership:** The award is offered in partnership with the Oxford Graduate Scholarship Matched Funding scheme.

**How to apply:** There is no separate application process. All applicants should apply to the University of Oxford under the standard procedures for graduate degrees for 2020-21. Applications should be made by the January deadline for your eligible course. If there are two or more candidates of equal academic merit, priority will be given to the candidate who has listed Wolfson as their first choice college on their University application form. The Scholar will become a member of Wolfson College for the duration of their studies.
